Dear Friends in Christ,

Sex trafficking is the second largest illegal industry worldwide and the fastest growing. Here in the United States, the average age of entry into “the life”, as it is often called by those in it, is 14-16 years of age. Traffickers prey on young girls who are starving for love, who have often suffered childhood abuse or familial neglect. Because of their unmet need for love and affection, these girls can become easy targets for men who provide shelter, shower them with gifts, give the girls complements, and pay attention to them in so many other ways. This grooming process enables them to forge disordered bonds before taking advantage of them.

Sadly, these children are on the receiving end of so many of the evils of our society. The rise in sex trafficking is directly linked and dependent upon the abortion industry, the widespread acceptance of contraception, pornography, and the breakdown of the family, to name a few. Pope St. John Paul II when he was Bishop of Krakow, wrote a philosophical work called Love and Responsibility in which he wrote that the opposite of love, when it comes to the relationship between man and woman, is not hatred, but use. We clearly see this corrupted behavior in sex trafficking – the victim is used by the trafficker for money and by the buyer for a moment of fleeting pleasure.

The damage this use does, especially over a long period of time, is substantial and consequential.

Here at Children of the Immaculate Heart, we place the person at the core of our programs in the effort to restore a sense of self-worth and dignity to those who come to us. All we do is centered around the central purpose of helping them to believe in love – and ultimately in the love of the Eternal Father for each one of them. Thank you for helping us make this work possible!
